Supplemental Instruction (SI) is a group study organization. Students enrolled in supported courses can register for a study table for free.

Study tables meet as small groups of 6-10 students for 50 minutes, once per week, weeks 2-10 of the term.

Study tables are highly collaborative and interactive. Each study table is led by a trained peer educator who has succeeded in the course in the past.

Sometimes it can feel like everyone else in the class gets the material, but at SI you'll see that your peers have many of the same questions that you do! You'll be able to talk through content that you feel confident in and through concepts that you want more clarity in.

SUPPLEMENTAL INSTRUCTION IS:

FREE: SI is available to all students registered for a SI-supported course.

FOCUSED: We still do practice problems at tables, but we don't do homework. The goal is to build your skills and confidence.

PLANNED: We know that group study sessions can easily become sidetracked. This is why SI Leaders prepare weekly plans to ensure that things move effectively and efficiently.

ACTIVE: In their plans, SI leaders design activities to cover the relevant content. This means that no two tables will be the same from week to week or SI Leader to SI Leader.

YOU: SI relies on students to bring their collective knowledge to the table (this may be a lot, or it may be a little), so that we can learn together.
